THREE DOG RELAY FOR CHARITY

Entry Form

What is it? Three dog & handler teams, 2 Large and 1 Small, form a team, carry the baton, master the obstacles and the course, finesse the baton exchanges and earn the smallest time + faults score to win the prize: A \$500 donation from TLC to the 'good cause' of your choice!

When is it? After the Regional Championship runs on Sunday and before the Awards, perhaps 4-5pm.

Where is it? Most likely in the Standard Ring 2, tho listen to the announcements on the day.

Who can play? All dogs must have an AAC Dog ID#. Dogs and Handlers must be entered in some events during our 3 day Championship weekend. A small dog is considered to be any jump height other than 20" & 24". The 2 large dogs will jump the same height, it may be the lower of the 2 large dogs' current AAC height. There will be no spread jumps and the Aframe will be at 5'6", so please plan accordingly.

How to enter? Teams must submit the attached Entry Form by May 22, 2018 by emailing it to tollhaven@gmail.com with "3 Dog Relay" in the subject line. Only ten teams will compete, if more than ten apps are received, we will draw for teams on May 23 and the entered teams will be posted on May 25.

Cost? Cost is \$30 per team. Teams also have to submit a Team Name, Team Song to play during their run and Team costumes may earn bonus points!!!!
